


While we have not had ministry programs happening here on our campus for the last couple of months, there has been plenty of ministry happening. Through online worship services we helped more people than normal encounter Jesus. Several small groups continued gathering virtually to spiritually equip adults, students and kids alike. We've seized opportunities to engage our community through loving service and essential worker care. As restrictions and guidelines are easing, the Staff and Leadership Team have developed a plan to slowly and safely open the doors to some of our on-campus ministry.

INITIAL RE-ENTRY PHASE

Sunday Worship Service:

- o Starting June 7th, we will open the campus for services at 9:00 and 11:00 with limited seating
- You can reserve your seat online through our website beginning each Wednesday for that weekend's services
- o Sanitizing of our entire facility will be done in preparation each week and between services
- o Strict guidelines will be in place for entry into the facility (outlined below)
- o Online services will continue but will move back to 9:00 and 11:00 starting June 7th





- o Starting June 7th, student ministry will have "open air" youth group on campus each Sunday evening
- o A mid-week smaller group event will happen on alternating Wednesday nights for middle and high school

Coastal Kids:

- Sunday morning kids' services will remain online only during this phase and will be streamed on our website, Coastal Kid's Facebook page, and church App for viewing at 9:00, 11:00, or on demand
- o Our Sunday on campus environments for kids will be unavailable
- VBS has been scheduled for July 20-24 here on campus with an alternative at-home plan if necessary



Life Groups:



- o Groups are encouraged to start meeting again in person whenever they feel comfortable doing so
- o Due to the strict sanitizing guidelines we are adhering to, groups that normally meet on campus are asked to either meet outside or at an alternate location during this phase

GUIDELINES AND SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Facility Precautions

- o We have increased our routine cleaning regimen
- o Our facility will be sanitized each week before every service
- o Touch-free hand sanitizer stations will be placed throughout the facility
- o A/C filters will be changed more frequently to create healthy ventilation
- o Doors will be propped open or opened by a Guest Services volunteer
- o Water coolers will be unavailable
- o Info cards, envelopes and pens will be removed from seatbacks
- o Seating will be set at social distance guidelines in clusters of 2, 3, and 4; ONLY family units should sit in clusters together

Program Precautions

- o Coffee bar service will be suspended during this phase
- o To avoid potential cross contamination, we will not be passing bulletins, communion, or offering baskets
- o An offering box will be placed at the back of the auditorium

Personal Precautions

- o We request that if you are sick, have been around a person who is sick, or have underlying health issues that you kindly join us online for our service
- o We request that before entering the facility you wash your hands at the temporary sink in the courtyard and use the hand sanitizer stations frequently throughout your time in the facility
- o Please help us create a touch-free environment and be mindful of physical contact with other people
- o Facemasks are optional but highly recommended for the protection of others
